## Membership

**Regular Membership**—Active members of the Alberta Teachers' Association and associate members who are ineligible for active membership as specified in ATA bylaws are eligible for regular membership in this council.

**Student Membership**—Student members of the ATA may join this council and are entitled to all the benefits and services of council membership except the right to hold office.

**Life Membership**—Retired members of the ATA as specified in ATA bylaws are eligible for life membership in the council and are entitled to all the benefits and services of council membership except the right to hold office.

## Subscription Service

Persons or organizations ineligible for active or associate membership in the ATA, such as school support staff, parents and libraries, as well as retired teachers and nonactive teachers, may connect with the council by paying a subscription fee. Payment of the subscription fee includes entitlement to receive the council's publications, as well as other services determined by the council, but does not provide membership in the council.
